



Collaboration with the research community

Must follow **agency formatting guidelines**



No section-specific volume limit



Information must be **self-contained**

Carefully read the funding opportunity/program and the materials the reviewers will read



Review the tri-agency CV instructions and frequently asked questions



Download the tri-agency CV template



Start early: it may take a day or more to write your first narrative CV



Transition to the tri-agency CV

CIHR transition plan

- Since early 2025, CIHR has been gradually transitioning to the tri-agency CV for its FOs, moving away from the Canadian Common CV (CCV).
- CIHR continues to assess all upcoming FOs to identify those suitable for transition to the tri-agency CV.
 - 16 FOs using the tri-agency CV have launched this year.
 - 11 additional FOs will launch using the tri-agency CV in the upcoming months.
- The new tri-agency CV will be introduced in the Project Grant competition no earlier than the Spring 2027 competition.

NSERC transition plan

- NSERC has been piloting a narrative CV in the Discovery Horizons funding opportunity for the past four competitions, including the current one.
 - The tri-agency CV will be implemented in Discovery Horizons for the 2027 competition.
 - NSERC is also exploring the possibility of implementing the tri-agency CV in the Arthur B. McDonald Fellowships for the 2027 competition
- Other NSERC funding opportunities will begin to use the tri-agency CV once they onboard onto TGMS. The community will be advised in advance.



SSHRC transition plan

- FOs launched on the Convergence Portal since December 2024.
 - i.e.: Impact Awards, Policy Innovation Partnership Grants, Canada Excellence Research Chairs.
- Not applicable to core FOs until the transition to the Tri-agency grants management solution (TGMS).
 - e.g.: Insight Grants, Insight Development Grants, Partnership Grants, Partnership Development Grants, Partnership Engage Grants, Connection Grants, and Canada Research Training Awards Suite
