MentorSTEP Internships USask Faculty Expression of Interest

Overview

MentorSTEP is a partnership between the University of Saskatchewan and the Saskatoon Tribal Council (STC), funded by the International Minerals Innovation Institute (iMii). It aims to support young Indigenous women (First Nations, Métis, or Inuit) enrolled in STEM or related disciplines (science, technology, engineering and math, as well as business, health and environment) to pursue careers in **Saskatchewan's mining industry**. Internships

Summer research internship funds are available. USask faculty may support one or more qualified students (female undergraduate students who are First Nations, Métis, or Inuit) to pursue summer internship opportunities. Faculty are expected to provide a robust, supervised internship opportunity using USask policies and procedures (i.e. conducting interviews, writing letters of offer, human resources guidelines, safety, payroll). USask faculty identify potential USask students, or support existing or anticipated students who have applied to you for opportunities but may meet our guidelines and criteria. *A limited number of internships are available for summer 2021. USask campus faculty qualify for up to \$4500 in funding support. Applications clearly associated with or of benefit to Saskatchewan's mining industry will receive priority.*

Students who are accepted for a MentorSTEP summer research internship may receive site visits, follow up and/or be interviewed for promotional purposes.
